TOURNAMENT DETAILS

There will be one section using **Baku Acceleration** to determine pairings.

Entrants **must** be under 2000 FIDE **AND** ECF in the published August rating lists for tournament eligibility.

All moves are to be played in 80 minutes plus a ten-second increment per move completed.

Three half-point byes can be taken. If a bye is taken in the last round, it will be zero-point.

The entry fee is £60 and the prize fund is over £1000. Full breakdown later in this document.

Seniors prize will be 65+. If your age on August 30 is 65 or above, you are eligible for the prize. If fewer than 3 over 65s enter the event, the age threshold will be lowered by five years until there are more than three players competing for the prize, OR until the threshold is lowered to 50.
